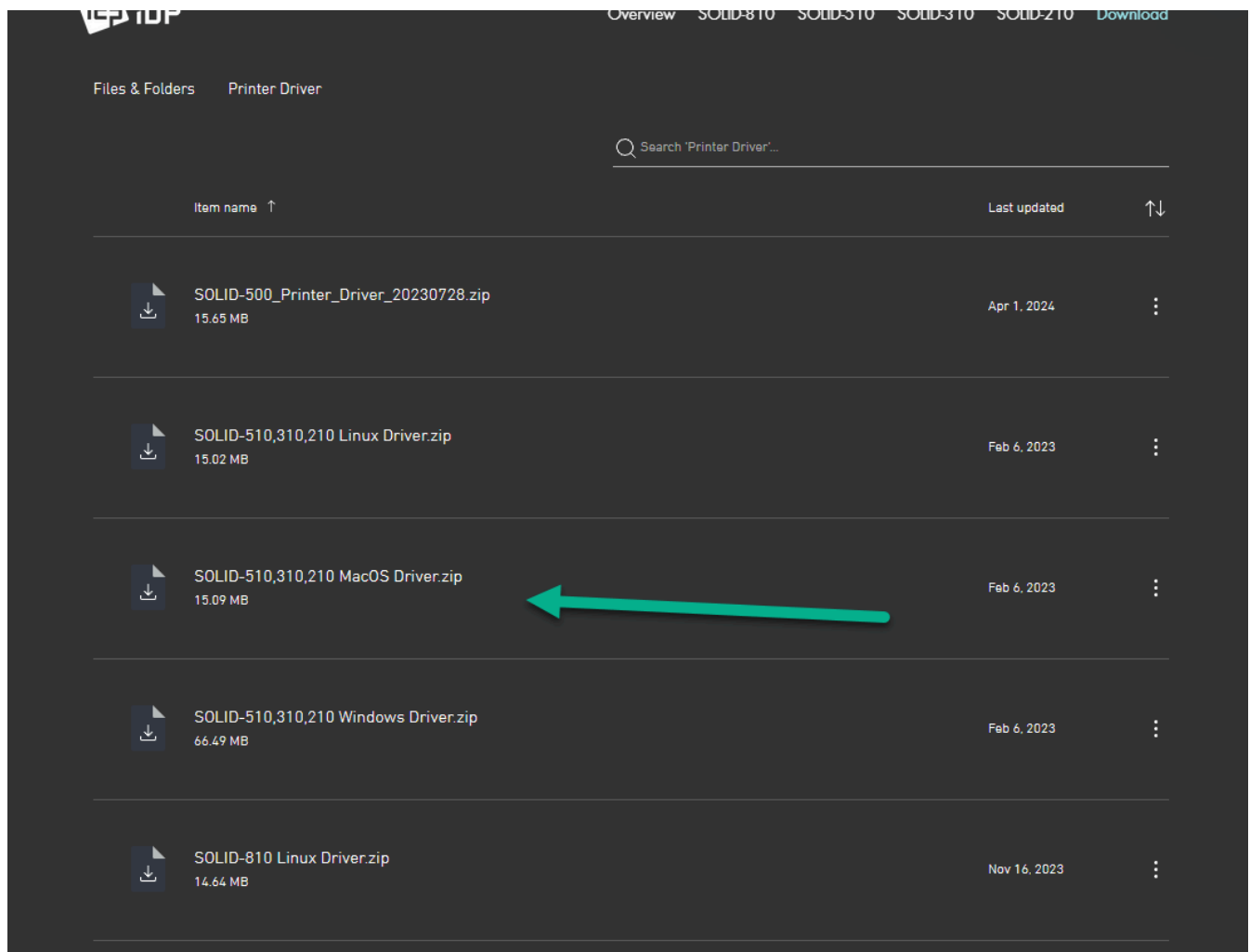
Follow

1. Connect Power Cable. DO NOT flip the Power Switch On
2. Install a compatible ribbon into the cartridge and insert the cartridge into the printer. [See the video for reference.](#)
3. Go to this [link](#) and click Printer Driver folder.
4. Download the driver for MAC OS as below

5. Download it and you may need to unzip it. Sometimes MAC will automatically unzip it.

6. You should be able to see the downloaded driver in the Downloads folder. Normally will be on the taskbar on the lower right corner.



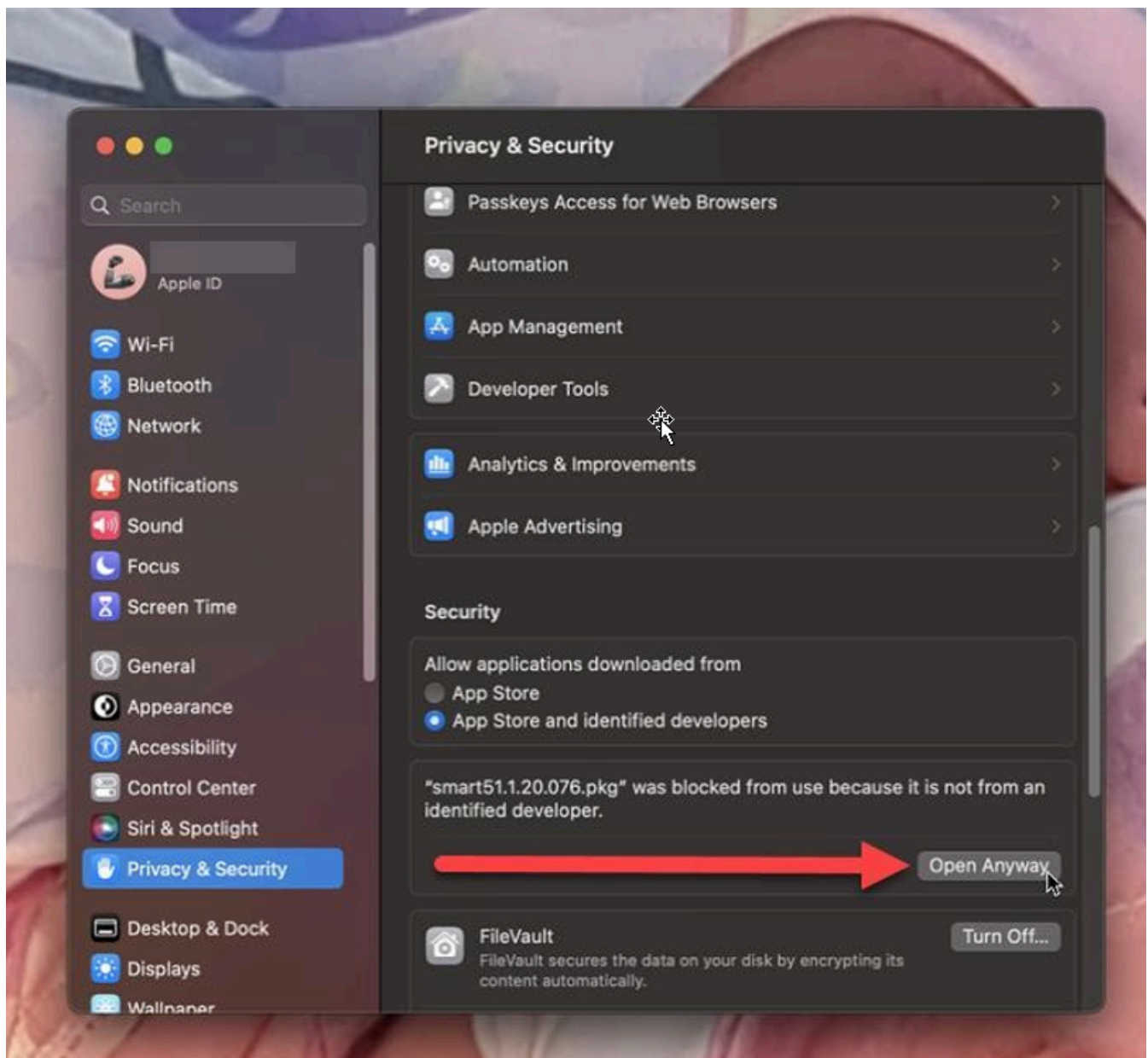
7. Run the downloaded Printer Driver installer. In most cases, you would get this message or similar:



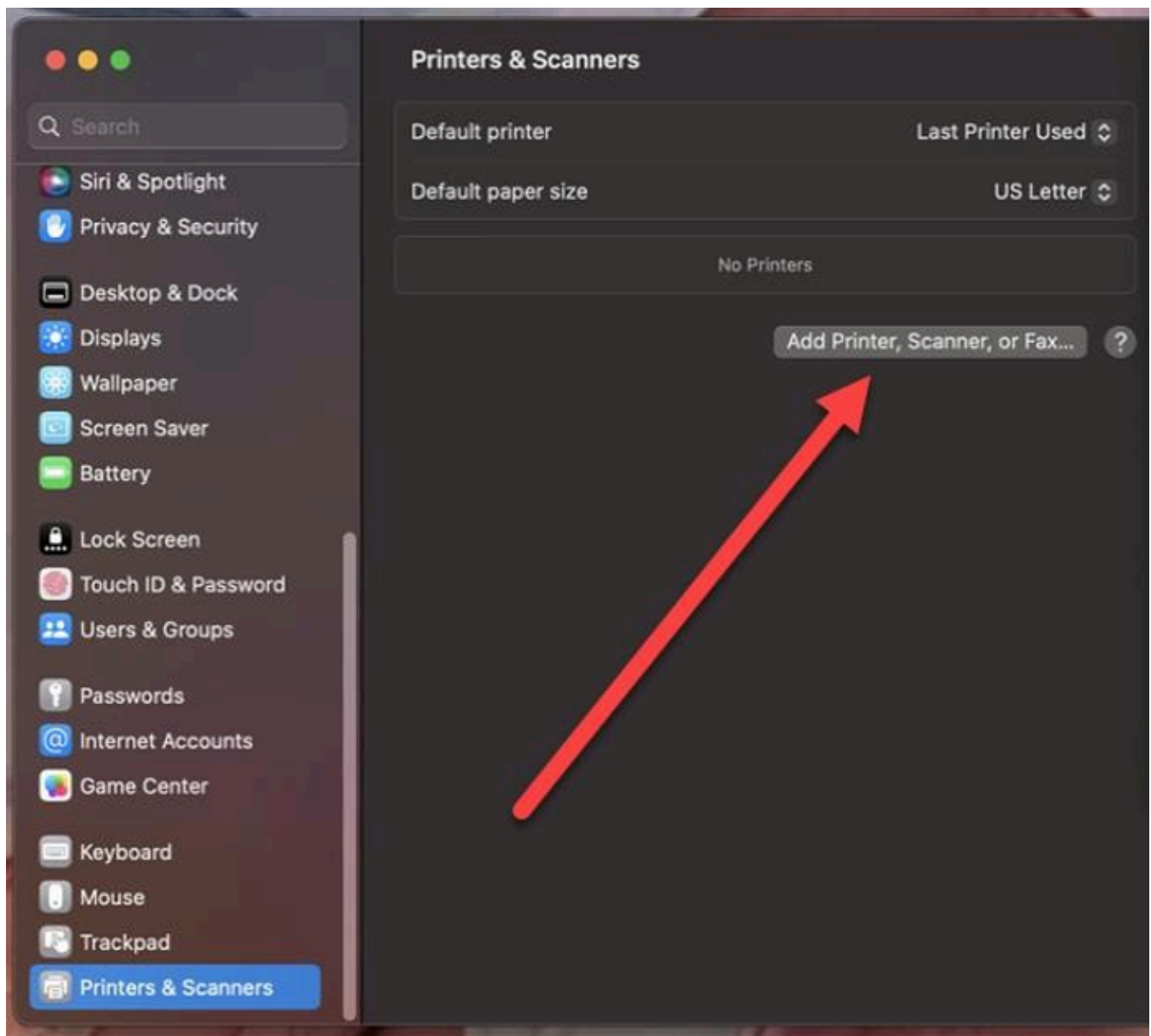
8. Go to System Preferences or System Settings by clicking the Apple icon in the upper left corner.



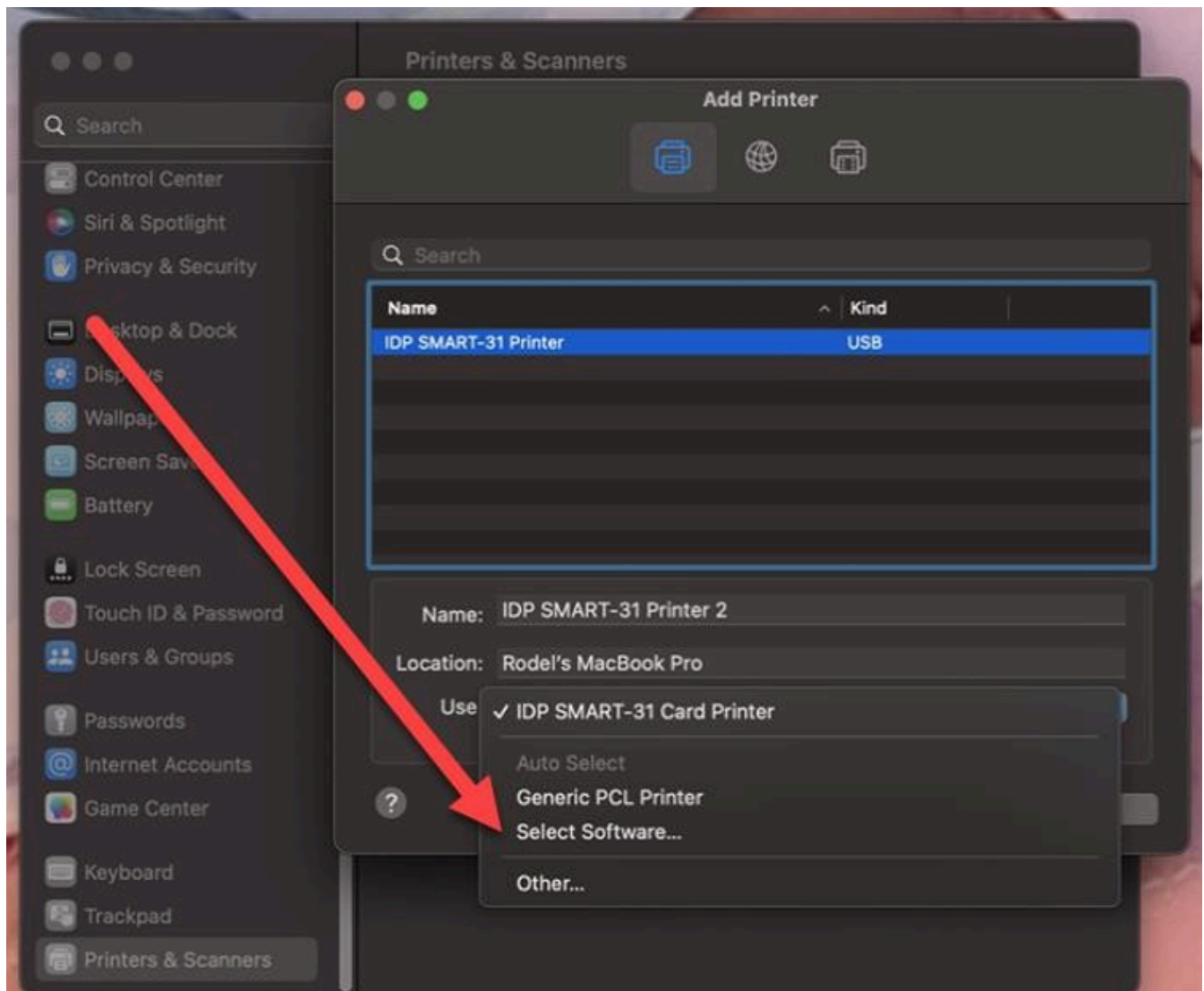
9. For the latest MAC OS version, you need to go to Privacy & Settings or Privacy & Security. Scroll Down and you should be able to see the driver being blocked. You need to click Open Anyway as below:



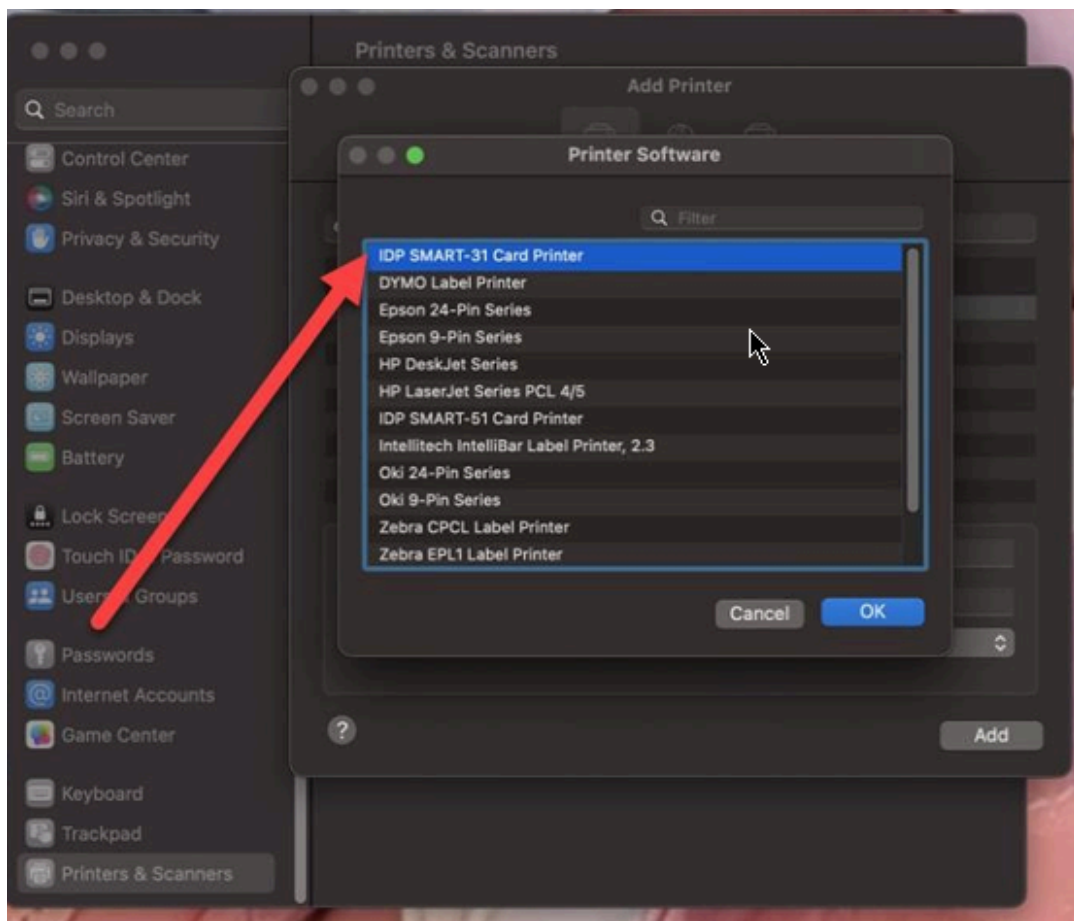
10. After installing the printer driver software, connect and turn the printer on then please open System Preference by choosing Apple menu > System Preferences. Then go to Printers & Scanners and click Add Printer, Scanner or Fax.



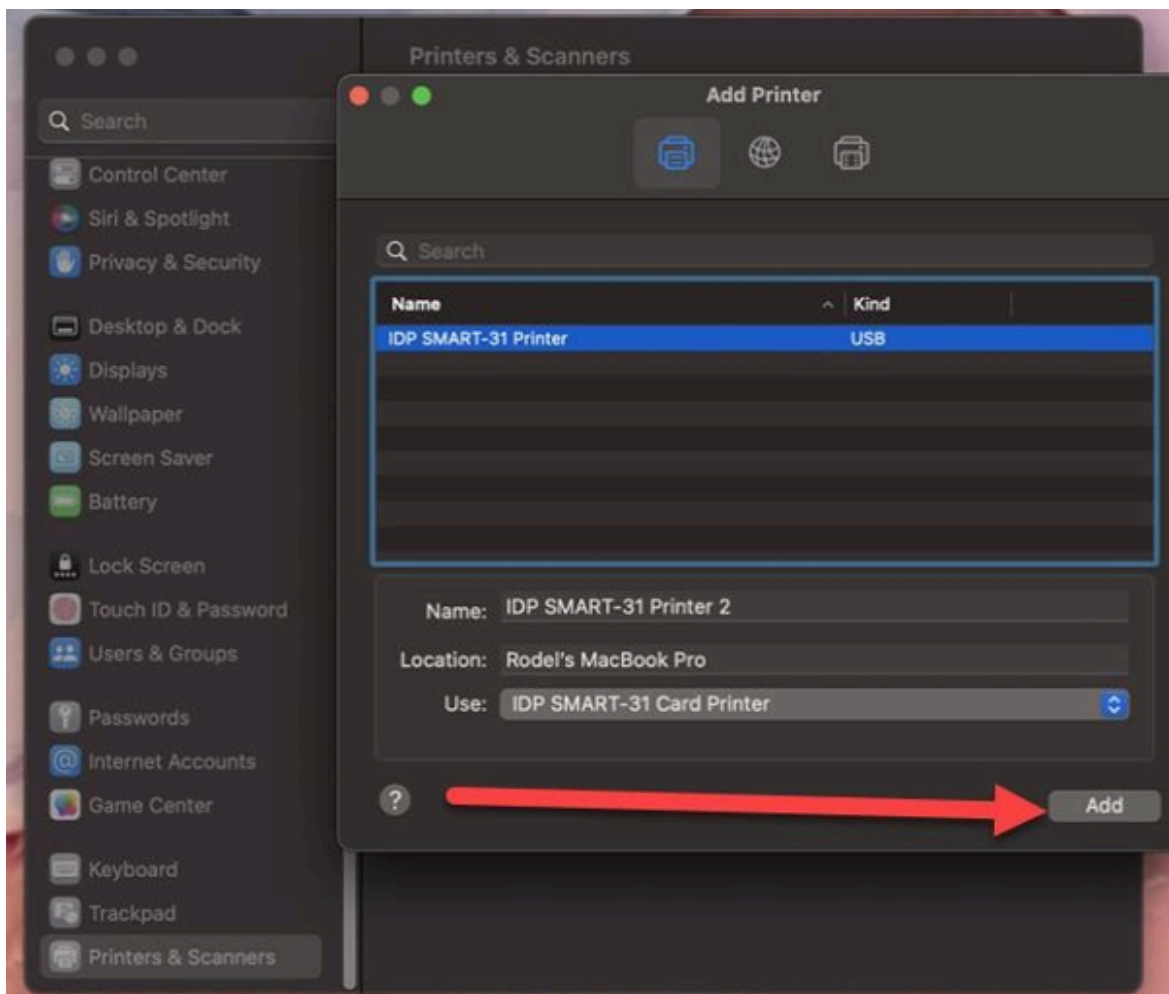
11. You should see Add Printer window then select the Connected IDP printer, then under the "Use" Dropdown select "Select Software":



12. You should see the Printer Software window. Select the printer type you have then click OK:



13. On the Add Printer window, click the Add button. You can rename it to your desired name:



14. You should be able to see the printer now under Printer & Scanners as ready to use:
